

Remember to use capital letters, full stops and other punctuation.











## Year 1

Today you will be learning to use question marks at the end of question sentences. Watch the bitesize video before completing this page in your Grammar punctuation and spelling text book.






## Year 2


Today you will be learning to decide where question marks need to be used in what types of sentences.
