

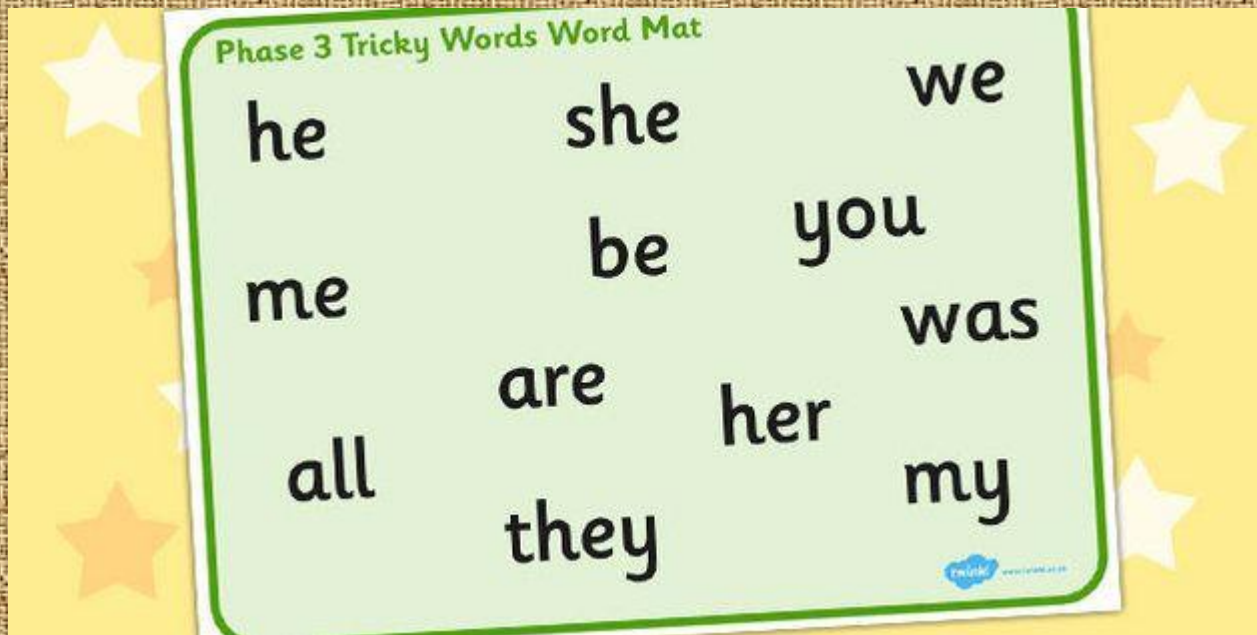

# Warm up

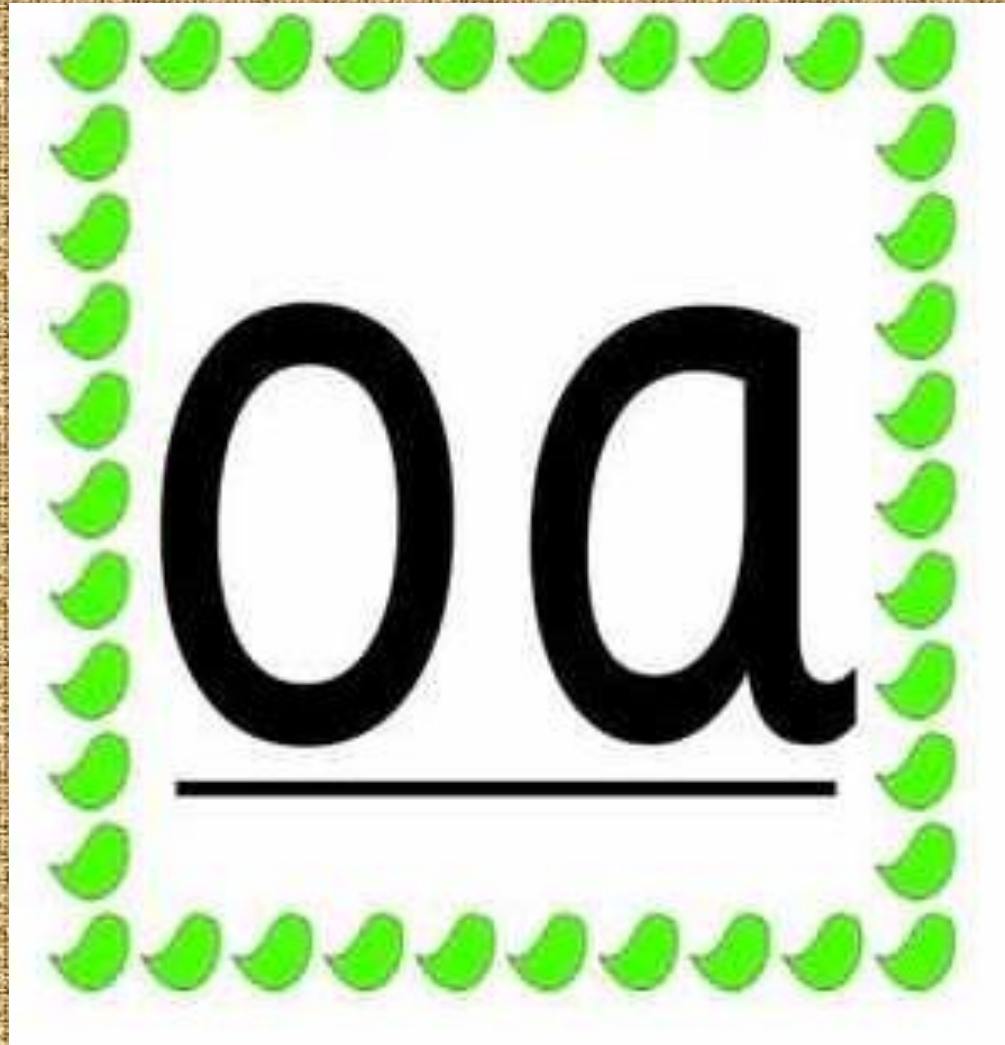
Write these tricky words on pieces of paper.

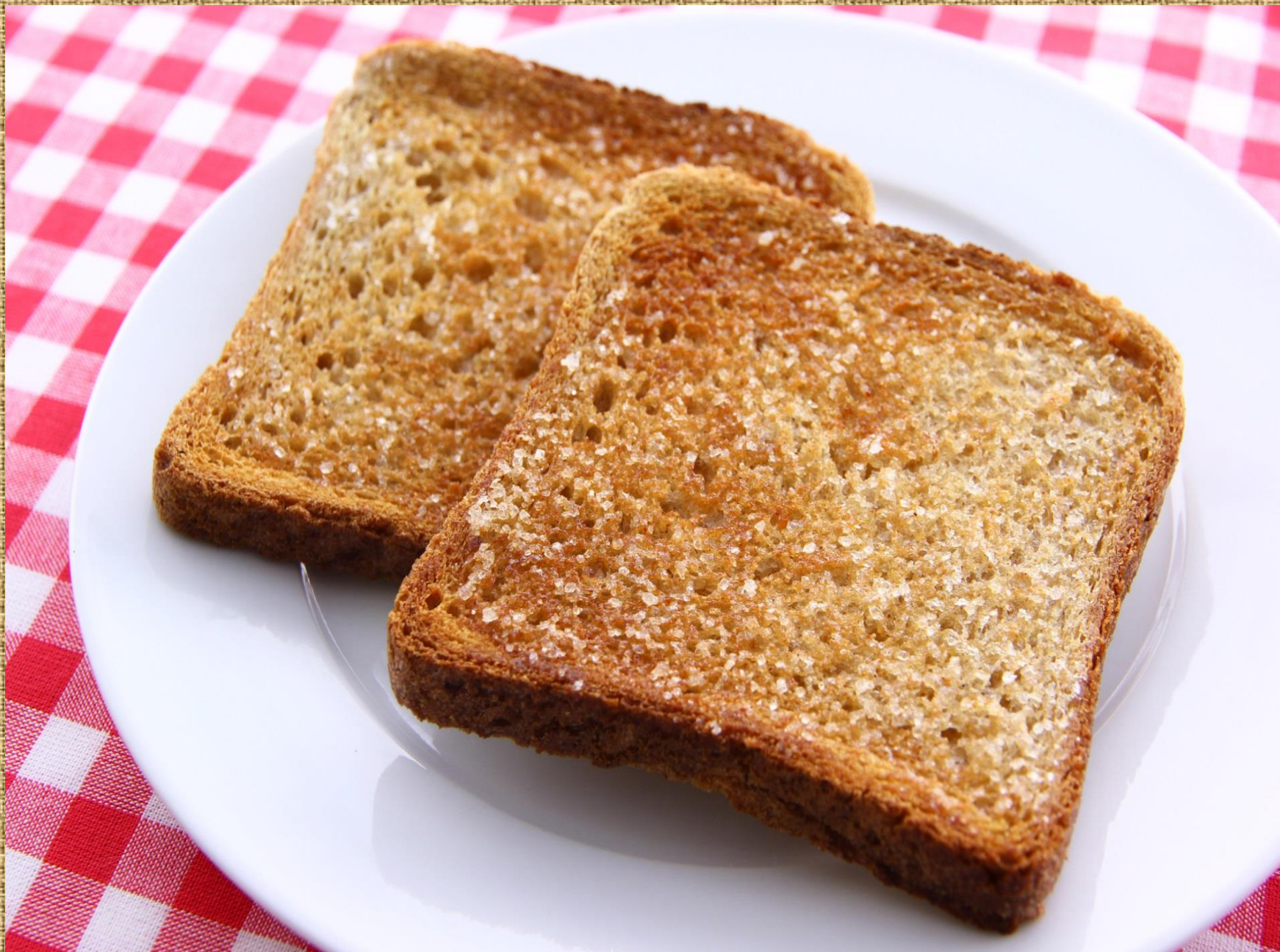

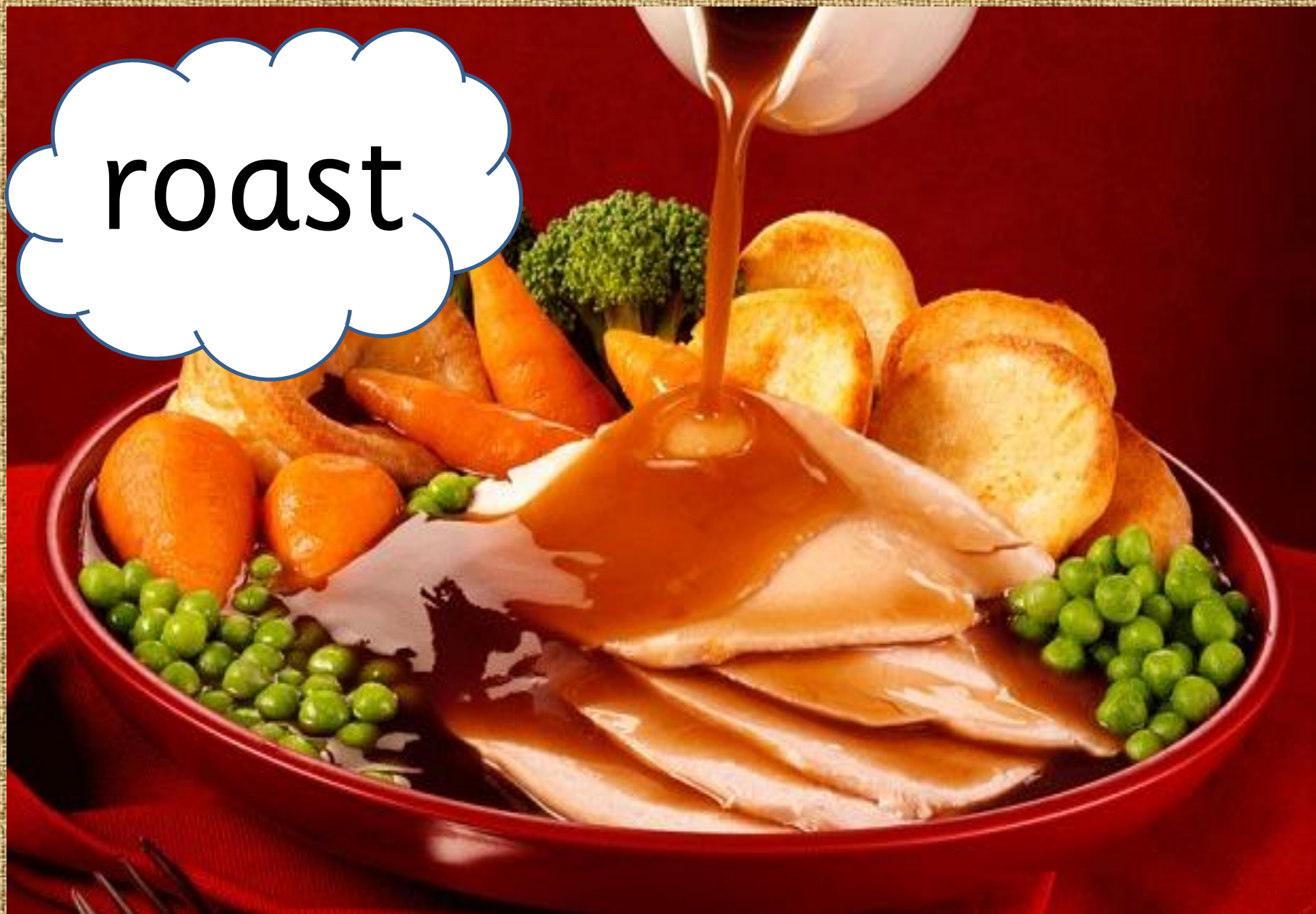
