- Access to Accelerated reader reading quizzes and star test to measure reading progress at home and online reading books linked to school book band colours.

## Where the class teacher is well:

- Microsoft Teams meet and greet with the teacher at 9.30am each day.

Please note that we are currently working on a plan to implement the use of Microsoft Teams and train our pupils to use this to meet and greet with their class teachers. Should a lockdown occur in the very near future this provision may not be ready to commence. We have to ensure that all of the online platforms we use are secure and we are currently processing a grant to enable us to purchase the rights for all pupils to use MS Teams via their own personal email address.
