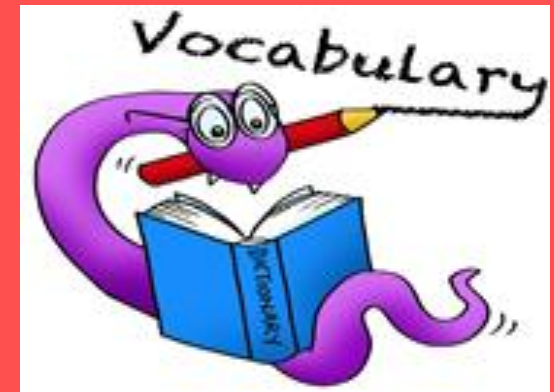
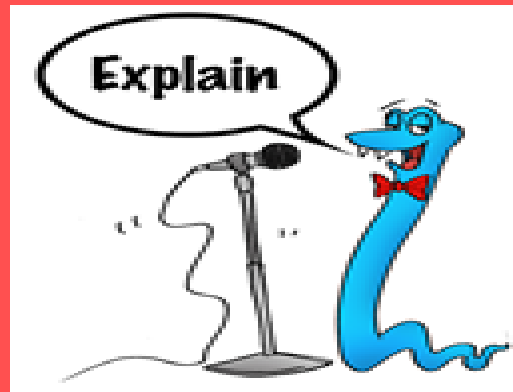
- Year 2 – Spellings – How many months of the year can you spell?
